Job Overview

The brewery helper will provide Brewhouse support and be in training for the Assistant Brewer position at Heroes Restaurant and Brewery. The brewery helper will also provide support with all cellar and packaging operations. The brewery helper will support laboratory operations and receive remedial training. Operations and upkeep of the facility to ensure cleanliness at all times will be the focus for this position.

This position will be required to provide aid to all facets of the restaurant and kitchen operations as needed to ensure the success of Heroes Restaurant and Brewery. This position shall require the respective candidate show passion for the process of brewing and an appreciation for beer.

Hours will vary (20-30 hours/week) to align with staffing and to meet the needs of production. The brewery helper will also be required to participate in events and festivals.
